

RATTLESNAKE RIDGE GOLF CLUB – C A R T R U L E S

Following these cart rules will make for better conditions, less wear patterns, and more importantly, increase the safety of our members, carts and personal vehicles.

Golf Course

For the safety of everyone and the condition of the course...

- Return carts to the path once you reach the painted white line.
- Keep all four tires on the path at all times when the cart rules are cart path only.
- It is cart path only on par 3 holes at all times.
- Scatter means scatter, try not to follow other cart tracks when entering and exiting fairways.
- Return to the path at a 90 degree angle from the fairway when your cart is 75 yards away from the green, or by the white line.
- Keep all four tires on the path when traveling around greens and tees.
- Follow all signage and do not drive through roped or staked off areas.
- Do not drive at any time through fescue or no-mow areas.
- Please watch and yield for traffic any time you cross Rattlesnake Drive.

Practice Facility and Parking Lots

For the safety of everyone and their personal vehicles...

- Follow the cart path from the cart staging area along the designated cart path to the practice facility. Do not cut through the parking lot.
- Park your golf cart on the cart path, not in the grass.
- Follow the cart path back to the staging area to start your round or return your cart.
- Do not take your cart to your personal vehicle in parking lot before, after, or during a round.

Push/Pull Carts, Motorized or Not

For the condition of the course...

- Push carts should be kept 15-30 feet from all edges of tees and greens, remaining on cart paths in these areas.
- Push carts should never be taken across tees or greens.
- Push carts should be directed around greenside bunkers and should never be taken between narrow gaps between the green and surrounding bunkers.
- Push carts should never be taken across excessively wet areas.
